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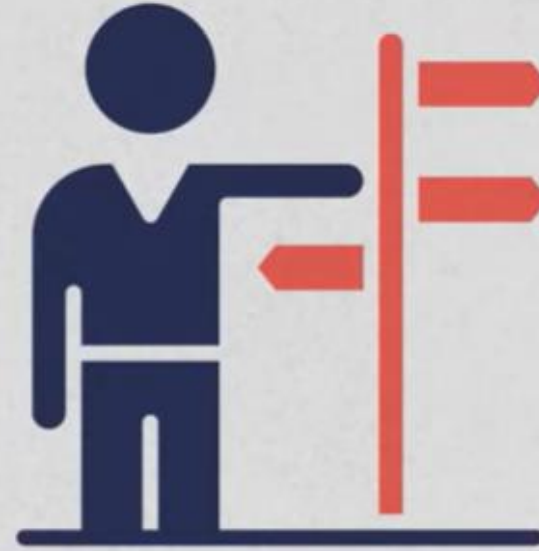

INTRODUCTION TO STOCK MARKET

“Stock market is nothing but a place where you can become a partner in big companies.

When you buy a stock, you are not just trading
— you are owning a part of that business.”



- A platform to buy & sell shares
- Ownership in companies
- Example: Reliance, TCS, HDFC Bank

WHY **STOCK** **MARKET** EXISTS?

**“Companies need money to grow...
Investors need opportunities to grow wealth...
Stock market connects both.”**



- Companies raise money
- Investors grow wealth
- Economic growth

HOW PEOPLE MAKE MONEY?

“There are only two ways to make money — Either price goes up... or you trade the movement.”



This is a more advanced mindset

- You don't care if price goes up or down
- You trade volatility (movement itself)

Ways to do this:

- Short selling → profit when price falls
- Options trading → profit from volatility
- Intraday/scalping → profit from small moves both directions

👉 This works in any market condition (up, down, sideways)

TYPES OF MARKET PARTICIPANTS

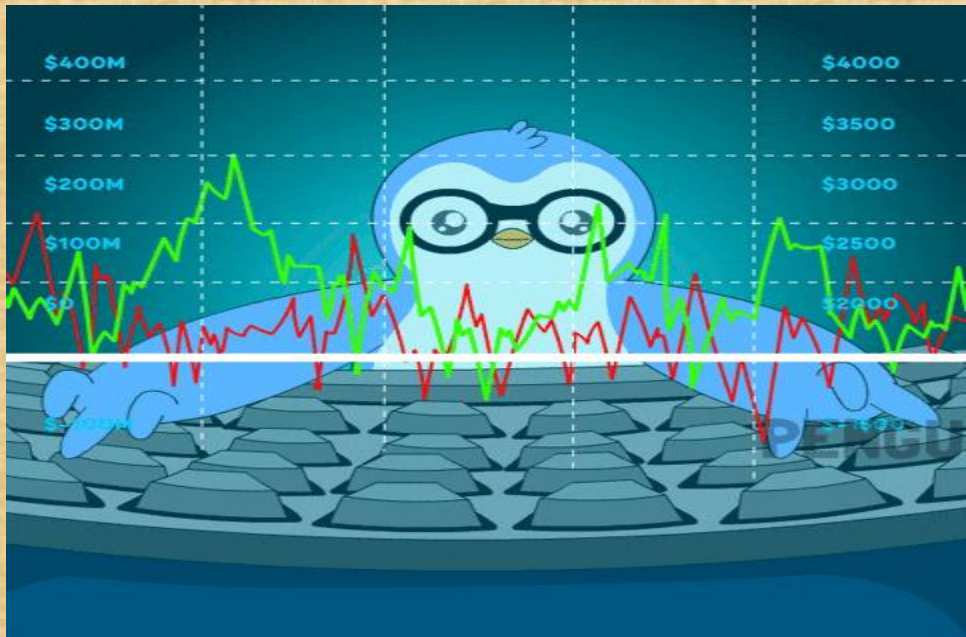
**“Market doesn’t move randomly...
It moves because of big players.”**



- Retail traders
- Institutional traders (FIIs, DIIs)
- Operators / Smart money

REALITY OF MARKET

“If stock market was easy... everyone would be rich.”



- 90% traders lose money
- No system
- Emotional trading

MARKET STRUCTURE

“Before trading, you must understand what the market is doing.”



- Uptrend
- Downtrend
- Sideways



What is Equity

What is Equity (Shares)?

Equity represents ownership in a company.

When you buy shares:

- You become a partial owner
- You benefit from company growth
- You take risk if company declines

“Higher risk = Higher potential reward”

Major Stock Exchanges in India

- NSE (National Stock Exchange)
- BSE (Bombay Stock Exchange)

These are platforms where buying and selling happens.



“Exchange = Marketplace for stocks”

WHAT IS INDEX

What is an Index?

An index represents a group of top companies.

Examples:

- **NIFTY 50 – Top 50 companies**
- **BANK NIFTY – Banking sector**

“Index shows overall market direction”

Demat & Trading Account

Accounts Required to Trade

- Demat Account – Holds your shares
- Trading Account – Used to buy/sell



Without these, you cannot participate in the market

Order Types

Types of Orders

- **Market Order – Buy/Sell instantly**
- **Limit Order – Buy/Sell at specific price**
- **Stop Loss (SL) – Risk protection**

“Professional traders always use stop loss”

Basic Market Terms

Basic Market Terminology

- Bid Price – Buyer's price
- Ask Price – Seller's price
- Volume – Number of shares traded
- Liquidity – Ease of buying/selling

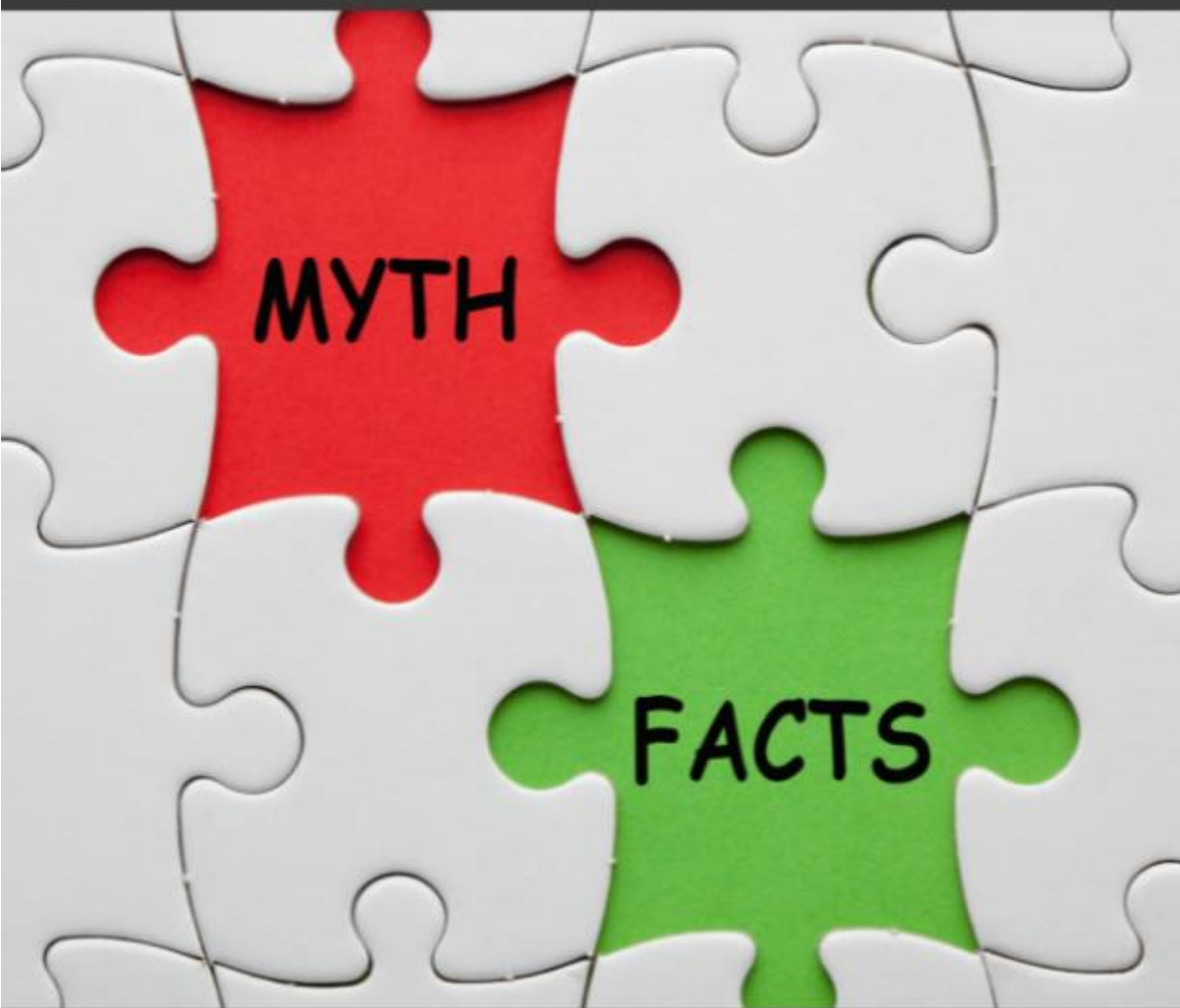

Vijay Kedia is a prominent Indian stock market investor with an estimated publicly disclosed net worth of approximately ₹1,200 crore to ₹1,500+ crore as of early 2026.



Key Net Worth Milestones

- 1985: Began investing with ₹5,000.
- 1986: Made his first big profit of ₹5 lakh.
- 1986–1989: Earned approximately ₹20–25 lakh.
- 1989: Reported net worth of ₹2 crore.
- 1990–91: Portfolio grew to roughly ₹10–15 crore.
- 2021: Net worth crossed \$5.5 billion, with Titan investment alone over ₹7,294 crore.
- August 2022: Peak net worth estimated at \$5.8 billion (approx. ₹50,000 crore). Wikipedia +6

As of early 2026, the equity portfolio managed by Rekha Jhunjhunwala (following Rakesh Jhunjhunwala's 2022 passing) via [Rare Enterprises](#) remains a powerhouse, with a net worth of over ₹52,241 Cr. to ₹59,542 Cr. from publicly listed stocks.
